

There will NOT be a bar on Saturday night. Please be discreet with party drinks in the halls and in the ballroom. (boutique)!






Hallway to quartet photo, all competitor warm-up, primp and stage




Stage area -- will be large enough for 11 riser sections with 4 steps.




Ballroom Seating Area with jumbotron screens for viewing




Entry to stage with pipe & and draping. Ramp and railing to the stage floor

Live Stream 2024



Chorus Marshalls

- Chorus Marshalls
- Each chorus should appoint chorus Marshalls. Best practice is one per row, but at least one per Chorus is required.
- Chorus Marshalls are responsible for gathering member's personal belongings in large tote bags, and carrying them through the pattern.
- Tote bags will be left off stage with the Host Chorus while competing.
- Chorus Marshalls will retrieve the tote bags after performing.
- There will be a Chorus Marshall meeting following the quartet competition in the front of the competition room. We will then review the responsibilities and walk the pattern to ensure everyone understands.



Quartet Hostesses

- Quartet Hostesses
- Each quartet will be assigned a quartet hostess from the Host Chorus to assist them in walking through the pattern.
- Hostess will meet you at your room at the assigned time. She will have a tote bag to carry your personal belongings.
- Quartets will receive the name and phone number of their hostess at the quartet reception on Thursday.
- Hostess will hold the belongings off stage while quartets compete and return them once the quartet is seated in the competition room.
- After performing, the hostess will lead quartets to their seats.
- Immediately after the competition, hostesses will accompany the top 5 quartets to the Mercuri room to assist in staging the Region quartet salute.
